We speak truth to power and bring youth and others to Washington, DC each spring to speak with Congress and top Administration officials.

We sponsor actions at Livermore Lab. This coming year, on August 6, we will mark the 75th anniversary of the U.S. atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki.

We provide time-critical research to connect the dots between Livermore Lab's new warhead (the W87-1) that will require new plutonium cores and the government's push to expand bomb core production at sites in New Mexico and South Carolina.

We win improvements to the environmental cleanup of our Northern California land and water that has been contaminated by nuclear weapons, and we actively involve disenfranchised communities, including Spanish speakers, in Superfund decision-making.

We promote the global abolition of nuclear weapons by changing U.S. policies that support their possession - and by participating at the United Nations to bring the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons into force.
